The land trust accreditation program recognizes land conservation organizations that meet national quality standards for protecting important natural places and working lands forever. The Golden State Land Conservancy is pleased to announce it is applying for renewal of accreditation. A public comment period is now open.

The Land Trust Accreditation Commission, an independent program of the Land Trust Alliance, conducts an extensive review of each applicant's policies and programs. Accreditation assures those looking to achieve conservation goals that an entity's institutional and financial integrity has been independently verified. It creates trust so the land can be saved forever.

The Commission invites public input and accepts signed, written comments on pending applications. Comments must relate to how the Golden State Land Conservancy complies with national quality standards. These standards address the ethical and technical operation of a land trust.
